Articulation	<p>A minimal pair is a pair of words that are similar but differ by one phoneme. For unit one, the minimal pair we will be looking at are the sounds [3:] as in verb and [ɔ:] as in cork</p> <p>To pronounce the [3:] sound your lips must be protruded and slightly separated. Your jaw needs to be slightly lowered, and your tongue must be in the midlevel of your mouth.
