Articulation	<p>The minimal pair for unit 4 is the ŋk / ŋ. The consonant blend [ŋk], as in think, is produced by placing the back of your tongue towards your soft palate. You need to make sure your airstream is continuous through your nose and that your vocal chords are vibrating.</p> <p>The additional [k] sound needs to be a short explosive one, like in ok. 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	<p>To produce the [ŋ] sound, place the back of your tongue towards your soft palate. You need to make sure your airstream is continuous through your nose and that your vocal chords are vibrating.</p> <p>The only difference between the two sounds is the explosive [k] at the end of [ŋk].
